# AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2023 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 2 - Receiving bids, (11-22-22), and Setting date of hearing, (12-12-22). Construction Estimate - \$650,000.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The project includes replacement of traffic signals at the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and Clark Street and the intersection of Indianola Avenue and Hartford Avenue, and replacement of the sidewalk curb ramps at the intersections to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.



# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2023 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 2, Activity No. 04-2022-009. The improvement includes new traffic signal system, vehicle detector loops, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalks, pavement markings, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 645-001/042, located at the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and Clark Street and the intersection of Indianola Avenue and Hartford Avenue.
- The estimated construction cost is \$650,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in fall 2023 and be completed by summer of 2024.
