AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2023 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 2: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Iowa Signal, Inc., Wayne Lesley, President, \$576,135.68.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2023 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 2 and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The project includes replacement of traffic signals at the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and Clark Street and the intersection of Indianola Avenue and Hartford Avenue, and replacement of the sidewalk curb ramps at the intersections to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.


Amount: \$576,135.68 construction contract (\$650,000 City Engineer's Estimate).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On November 7, 2022, under Roll Call No. 22-1710, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2023 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 2. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2023 Traffic Signal Replacement Contract 2, Activity ID 04-2022-009. The improvement includes new traffic signal system, vehicle detector loops, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalks, pavement markings, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 645-001/042, located at the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and Clark Street and the intersection of Indianola Avenue and Hartford Avenue.
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - o Iowa Signal, Inc., Grimes, IA, Low Bid
 - Van Maanen Electric, Inc., Newton, IA
 - o Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Newton, IA

- o TK Concrete, Inc., Pella, IA

- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on November 22, 2022.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Iowa Signal, Inc. (Wayne Lesley, President, 3711 S.E. Capitol Circle, Grimes, IA, 50111), in the amount of \$576,135.68, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in fall 2023 and be completed by summer of 2024.
