AGENDA HEADING:

Resolution approving grant agreement with Center at Sixth to provide matching funds for the Nonprofit Innovation Fund grant for the construction and development of a Black and Brown business incubator at 1714 6th Avenue.

SYNOPSIS:

On July 18, 2022, by Roll Call No. 22-1145, the Des Moines City Council approved an economic development grant in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 to serve as the required 10% matching funds in support of the Center at Sixth's Nonprofit Innovation Fund grant application made to Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA). In September, Center at Sixth was awarded a \$3,000,000 grant to construct and develop a Black and Brown business incubator as part of their project on 1714 6th Avenue.

The Office of Economic Development has established terms of a Grant Agreement which provides for non-project generated tax increment financing funds to be the source of the approved grant-match allocation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$300,000

Funding Source: Tax increment generated by the Metro Center Urban Renewal Area.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Center at Sixth business incubator is part of a larger project by Ashworth Development, LLC which will also include 32 dwelling units, 17 of those to be provided at an affordable rate.
- The subject site is currently owned by the 6th Avenue Corridor, who issued a Request for Qualifications in December 2020 for development of the property. In 2021, the 6th Avenue Corridor Board selected the proposal submitted by Marquas Ashworth and his team.
- Commencement of construction is planned for April 2023 with completion anticipated in the fall of 2024.
