AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Pennsylvania Avenue Rehabilitation from E. Washington to E. Jefferson - Receiving bids, (1-24-23), and Setting date of hearing, (2-20-23). Construction Estimate - \$330,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for rehabilitation of Pennsylvania Avenue roadway pavement from E. Washington Avenue to E. Jefferson Avenue including milling the existing pavement surface and overlaying with a new hot-mix asphalt surface. The project also includes replacement of the existing sidewalk with a new 10-foot-wide multiuse trail along the west side of Pennsylvania Avenue from E. Washington Avenue to E. Jefferson Avenue.

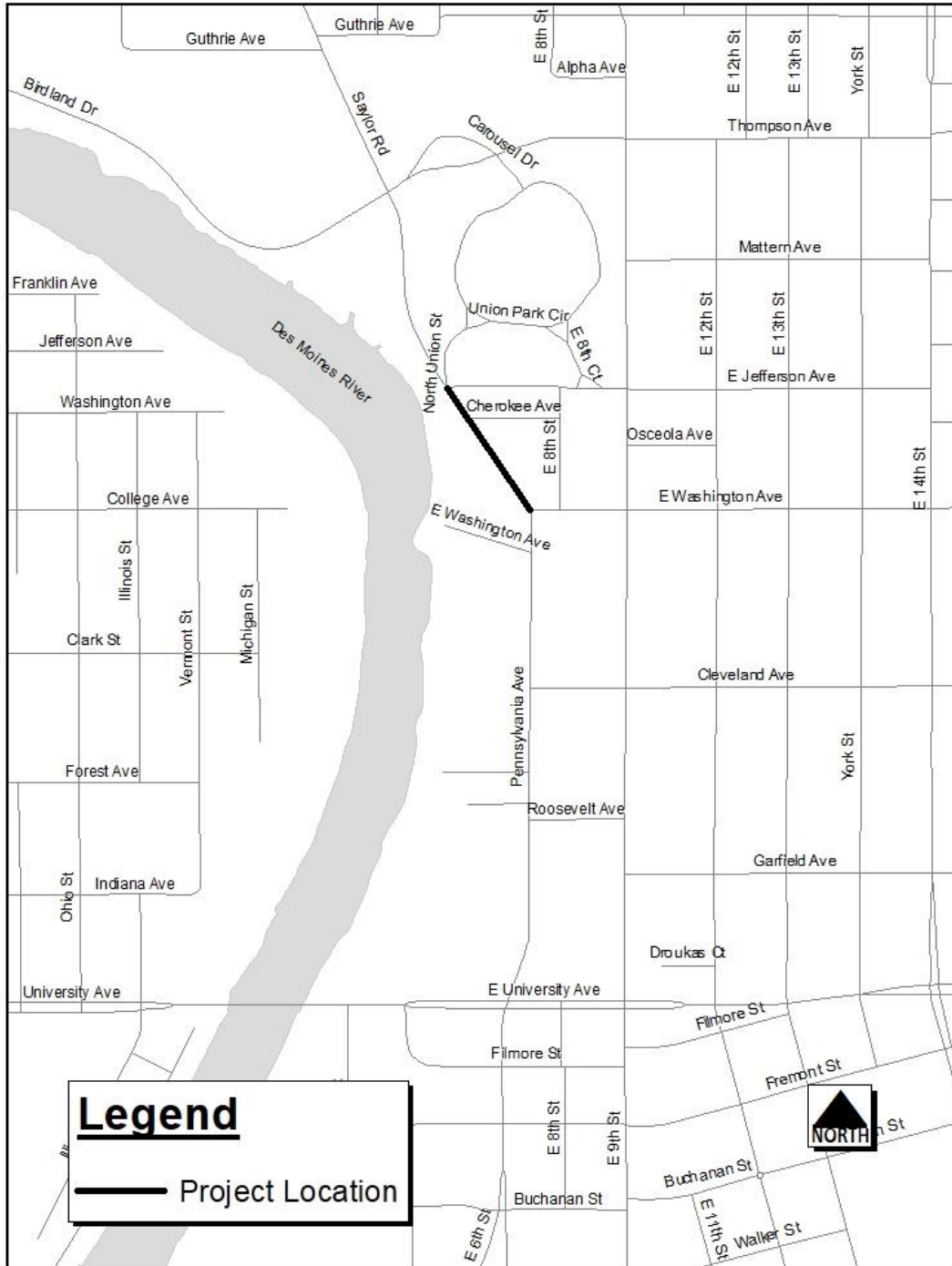
Amount: \$330,000 City Engineer's Estimate

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Pennsylvania Avenue Rehabilitation from E. Washington to E. Jefferson, Activity ID 06-2023-004. The improvements include Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) curb and gutter, milling 2-inch Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) paving, PCC trail, PCC driveways, earthwork and grading, pavement markings, water services, erosion control, restoration, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 648-218/246, located along Pennsylvania Avenue from E. Washington Avenue to E. Jefferson Avenue.
- The estimated construction cost is \$330,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.

- Construction of this project will start after June 3, 2023, to accommodate the Dam to Des Moines half marathon event and will be completed in fall 2023.
