ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Traffic and Transportation Division of the Engineering Department requested the Finance Department, Procurement Division, to purchase traffic paint. Traffic paint was competitively bid by IDOT and is available from Diamond Vogel Paint (PO Box 380, Orange City, IA 51041), per Iowa IDOT Contract 7697. Municipal Code Section 2-726(k) provides for the purchase of goods or services from contracts established by the State of Iowa Department of General Services, the IDOT, and the Iowa Communications Network, pursuant to procedures established by Chapter 8A Code of Iowa rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the City Purchasing Division.
- The traffic paint is used during the application of striping and demarcation of roadway lanes, bike lanes, crosswalks, etc. to provide visual guidance to motorists and pedestrians to improve safety.
