AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2023 HMA Residential Paving Program Contract 1 – LOSST - Receiving bids, (3-7-23), and Setting date of hearing, (3-27-23). Construction Estimate - \$1,054,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the paving of residential streets utilizing surface scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) to extend the useful service life of streets. The project also includes constructing Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant sidewalk curb ramps, and removal and replacement of Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) curb and gutter sections within the project locations.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2023 HMA Residential Paving Program Contract 1 LOSST, Activity ID 062023011. The improvement includes furnishing labor, equipment, and materials for the removal of existing HMA pavement and surfacing materials by milling/scarifying to an average depth of four (4) inches and six (6) inches, prepare subgrade/subbase, reconstruct with four (4) inches of HMA pavement with two (2) lifts, replace sections of PCC curb and gutter, and replace existing sidewalk ramps with ADA-compliant ramps, all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations and other locations as directed by the City Engineer within the City:
 - o S.E. 5th Street from E. Bell Avenue to Pioneer Road
 - o Lincoln Avenue from Merle Hay Road to Merklin Way

- 57th Street from Forest Avenue to Clark Boulevard
- Ovid Avenue from 56th Street to 54th Street
- o Reynolds Lane from Farwell Road to Arthur Avenue
- o Farwell Road from Tomlin Lane to Hubbell Avenue
- o Tomlin Lane from Guthrie Avenue to Arthur Avenue
- o Arthur Avenue from Lay Street to Farwell Avenue
- o Arthur Avenue from dead end west of Farwell Road to Reynolds Lane
- o Mahaska Avenue from E. 38th Street to E. 40th Street
- O Dubuque Avenue from Hubbell Avenue to E. 24th Street
- o 58th Street from Chamberlain Drive to Kingman Avenue
- o 37th Street from Beaver Avenue to Washington Avenue
- The estimated construction cost is \$1,054,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in spring 2023 and be completed in spring 2024. Construction work on the following two (2) locations shall be completed between June 5, 2023 and August 11, 2023 while school is out of session.
 - o Lincoln Avenue from Merle Hay Road to Merklin Way
 - o 57th Street from Forest Avenue to Clark Boulevard
