AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of a voluntary agreement on wages with AFSCME Council 61 Local 3673 for fiscal year (FY) 2024 (July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024).

SYNOPSIS:

Current collective bargaining agreement with AFSCME is a 5-year contract that began on July 1, 2020, and will end on June 30, 2025. The contract was reached voluntarily and includes a reopener to negotiate wages for the fourth and fifth years of the agreement. Nothing in the contract other than wages can be amended without mutual agreement. For the 1-year period beginning July 1, 2023, which is also the fourth year of the agreement, the City and AFSCME have agreed to a 3% across-the-board wage increase.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: The financial impact of the agreement is consistent with the proposed FY 2024 budget.

Funding Source: Des Moines Public Housing Agency.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• AFSCME represents 28 full-time employees in the Des Moines Public Housing Authority. These employees work in positions such as: case managers, inspectors, maintenance workers, administrative support, and accounting. The first three (3) years of the agreement included an annual across-the-board wage increase of 2.25%. A wage increase of 3.0% has been reached for the fourth year of the agreement (July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024). Wages for the fifth and final year of the agreement will be negotiated again next year.
