AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2023-2024 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as InRoads, LLC, Joseph J. Manatt, CEO, \$251,180.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2023-2024 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the timely maintenance of residential and arterial streets utilizing surface scarification and HMA overlay to improve the surface condition and extend the useful service life of the City's streets.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On February 20, 2023, under Roll Call No. 23-0202, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2023-2024 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2023-2024 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing, Activity ID 06-2023-008. The improvement includes scarification only of 2-inch and 3-inch average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Public Works Department, together with other incidental items and related work; all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations and other locations as directed by the Engineer within the City:
 - o 23rd Street from dead end north of Olive Avenue to dead end south of Rollins Avenue
 - o 23rd Place from dead end north of Olive Street to dead end south of Rollins Avenue
 - Day Street from 11th Street to 13th Street

- South Union Street from Porter Avenue to Payton Avenue
- o Holcomb Avenue from 38th Street to 34th Street
- o Park Avenue from West of S.W. 42nd Street to S.W. 37th Street
- o East Sheridan Avenue from East 38th Street to East 36th Court
- o 50th Street from Douglas Avenue to Madison Avenue
- S.W. 31st Street from Thornton Avenue to Park Avenue
- o 14th Place from Enos Avenue to University Avenue
- o 45th Place from Harwood Avenue to dead end north
- o Boston Avenue from 6th Avenue to 7th Street
- o East 23rd Street from University Avenue to Hubbell Avenue
- o Bancroft Street from Thomas Beck Road to S.W. 9th Street
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:

 - o OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on March 7, 2023.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by InRoads, LLC (Joseph J. Manatt, CEO, 4761 NE 20th Lane, Des Moines, IA, 50313), in the amount of \$251,180, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is scheduled to be completed by the summer of 2024.
