## **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of Demolition of 3125 Kingman Boulevard and 715 E Edison Avenue.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Approval of demolition of 3125 Kingman Boulevard and 715 E Edison Avenue and not assessing the costs of demolition and other fees associated with the public nuisance action to the property. This action will assist in the redevelopment of these two (2) properties in two (2) of the City's special investment districts by Invest DSM.

### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$450,000 (estimated demolition costs)

<u>Funding Source</u>: Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Adopted Budget, Page 90, ND414000 – Local Option Sales and Services, Blitz on Blight Program

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Invest DSM acquired 3125 Kingman Boulevard on February 17, 2023, and 715 E Edison Avenue on June 1, 2023. Both properties were under public nuisance actions by the City prior to their acquisition by Invest DSM and remain under the same action currently.
- These properties were progressing towards demolition by the City with a lien being placed against the property for the costs of demolition. These liens would have made the property difficult for redevelopment until the liens were waived. This process would prolong the duration of time that blight remains in these neighborhoods.
- With Invest DSM owning the property, it is recommended for the City to demolish the property and not assess the costs to the property as the City traditionally does. This will allow for the property to be redeveloped much faster.
