AGENDA HEADING:

Approving second amendment to purchase and sale contract between Nationwide Mutual Insurance Company and City of Des Moines, Iowa, dated September 12, 2022.

SYNOPSIS:

On September 12, 2022, the City Council approved a purchase agreement for an office building and parking garage located at 1200 Locust Street and 1200 Mulberry Street respectively as well as the assignment of a parking lot lease at 13th Street and Walnut Street. The City Council approved the First Amendment to this agreement on May 30, 2023.

This amendment contains four amended terms:

- Extends the due diligence period to October 31, 2023.
- Adds the purchase of the parking lot at 1300 Locust at no additional cost to the City of Des Moines.
- Sets the closing date on the surface parking lot and the office building to on or before December 28, 2023.
- Sets the closing date of the parking garage to on or before December 30, 2024.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: The purchase price is unchanged from the original agreement:

- 1200 Locust Street and the Assignment of Parking Lot Lease: \$30,000,000
 - o Includes earnest money in the amount of \$106,000
- 1200 Mulberry Street: \$10,600,000

<u>Funding Source</u>: Public hearings on capital loan notes, general obligation bonds, and general obligation urban renewal bonds are also scheduled for the August 7, 2023 City Council meeting.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• All remaining terms of the Agreement and First Amendment remain unchanged.
