SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes. Costs for sign installations and periodic maintenance of signs.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. A corner clearance is a parking restriction that extends 150 feet or less from an intersection. Corner clearances are typically installed to provide required sight distance at the intersection or facilitate turning movements onto narrow, residential streets where a parked vehicle might prevent two (2)-way traffic. A request for a corner clearance is typically generated from resident concerns. Staff has reviewed the following locations and determined corner clearances or corner clearance modifications are necessary.
 - E 37th Street and Indianapolis Avenue
 - 40th Place and Crocker Street
 - E 42nd Street and Wilson Avenue
 - 61st Street and Walnut Hill Drive
 - Clark Street and 31st Street
 - Nash Drive and Stephenson Way



The following revisions to the Municipal Code will place these changes into effect.

Sec. 114-2901. East Thirty-seventh Street--East University Avenue to Avenue Frederick M. Hubbell.

East Thirty-seventh Street, on the east side, from a point 100 feet south of the east leg of Indianapolis Avenue to a point 100 feet south thereof 70 feet north of the east leg of Indianapolis Avenue, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-2914. Fortieth Place--Center Street to Amick Avenue.

Fortieth Place, on the west side, from a point 35 feet south of Crocker Street to Crocker Street, no parking any time.

Fortieth Place, on the west side, from Crocker Street to a point 60 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-2924. East Forty-second Street to East Aurora Avenue.

East Forty-second Street, on the east side, from <u>a point 100 feet south of</u> Wilson Avenue to a point 50 feet north thereof of Wilson Avenue, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-2960. Sixty-first Street--Grand Avenue to Douglas Avenue.

Sixty-first Street, on the west side, from Grand Avenue to Walnut Hill Avenue <u>Drive</u>, no parking any time.

<u>Sixty-first Street</u>, on the east side, from a point 50 feet south of Walnut Hill Drive to Walnut Hill Drive, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-3082. Clark Street--Thirtieth Street to Sixty-third Street.

Clark Street, on the north side, from Thirty-first Street to a point 50 feet east thereof, no parking any time.

Clark Street, on the south side, from a point 60 feet east of Thirty-first Street to a point 50 feet west of Thirty-first Street, no parking any time.

<u>Clark Street</u>, on the north side, from a point 50 feet east of Thirty-first Street to a point 50 feet west of Thirty-first Street, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-3515. Nash Drive--Chautauqua Parkway to Hickman Road.

Nash Drive, on the east side, from a point 50 feet south of Stephenson Way to a point 60 feet north of Stephenson Way, no parking any time.
