AGENDA HEADING:

Acceptance of a proposal from MidAmerican Energy Company to install 12 streetlights and 12 pedestrian lights for E. 4th Street Reconstruction from E. Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway to E. Market Street, estimated at \$117,122.15.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend acceptance of a proposal from MidAmerican Energy Company (200 SE 3rd Street, Des Moines, Iowa, 50309) to install 12 LED streetlights on banner strength poles with 12 LED pedestrian lights on the sidewalk side of these same poles for E. 4th Street Reconstruction from E. Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway to E. Market Street.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The E. 4th Street Reconstruction from E. Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway to E. Market Street project includes the complete reconstruction of E. 4th Street and will provide a new street cross section that will include one (1) travel lane in each direction, parking on both sides, raised separated bike lanes on both sides, and sidewalks on both sides. The new cross section will also include permeable pavers for the parking surfaces and bioswales filled with trees, shrubs, and perennials along both sides of the street. Construction of this project began in spring 2023 and is anticipated to be completed by fall 2024.
- The proposal provides for MidAmerican Energy Company to:
 - Install 12 LED streetlights on banner strength black poles.
 - Install 12 LED pedestrian lights on the sidewalk side of these same poles.
- On March 27, 2023, by Roll Call No. 23-0373, City Council accepted a proposal from MidAmerican Energy Company to remove existing utility poles and relocate overhead utilities underground for E. 4th Street Reconstruction.

• The LED light fixtures will be installed on steel poles and served by underground conductors and will be billed to the City at the wood pole overhead rate. The estimate from MidAmerican Energy for the work is \$117,122.15 and is budgeted as part of the Market District Infrastructure Improvements project costs.
