Approve expansion of the Watrous South Neighborhood boundaries in accordance with the Neighborhood Recognition Policy.

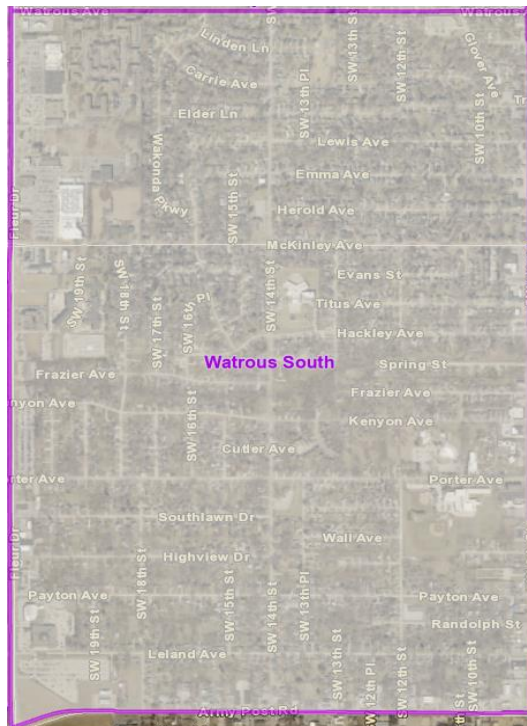
SYNOPSIS:

The Watrous South Neighborhood Association requests approval of a proposed boundary expansion of the Watrous South Neighborhood to include Army Post Road to the north, County Line Road to the south, SW 9th Street to the east, and Fleur Drive to the west.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The existing boundary is Watrous Avenue to the north, Army Post Road to the south, SW 9th Street to the east, and Fleur Drive to the west.



- The proposed boundary expansion includes Army Post Road to the north, County Line Road to the south, SW 9th Street to the east, and Fleur Drive to the west.



- Boundaries with the proposed expansion area include Watrous Avenue between SW 9th Street and Fleur Drive to the north, County Line Road between SW 9th Street and Fleur Drive to the south, SW 9th Street between Watrous Avenue and County Line Road to the east, and Fleur Drive between Watrous Avenue and County Line Road to the west.
- The proposed expansion area is not part of a recognized neighborhood association.
- Watrous South Neighborhood Association followed procedures for expansion in accordance with the Neighborhood Recognition Policy.
