AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2024 Riverwalk Improvements - Paver Replacement - Receiving bids, (11-28-23), and Setting date of hearing, (1-8-24). (Construction Estimate - \$600,000).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the restoration of sidewalk pavers and associated work along the Principal Riverwalk between Center Street and Vine Street along the west side of the Des Moines River.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2024 Riverwalk Improvements Paver Replacement, Activity ID 11-2023-018. The improvement includes the removal and replacement of deteriorated sidewalk concrete unit pavers, limestone pavers, black brick pavers, scarification, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) and associated work, all in accordance with the contract documents, located between Center Street and Vine Street along the west side of the Des Moines River, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$600,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to be completed by end of fall 2024.
- Contract documents require contractor to coordinate with Parks and Recreation Department's Hub Spot enclosed shelter reservation schedule.
