Ordering construction of the following: 2024 Sewer Repair Contract 1 - Receiving bids, (11-28-23), and Setting date of hearing, (1-08-24). (Construction Estimate - \$725,000).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the repair and replacement of deteriorated storm sewer infrastructure at multiple locations in Des Moines.



- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2024 Sewer Repair Contract 1, Activity ID 08-2022-003. The improvement includes the construction of storm sewer, manholes, intakes, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, earthwork and grading, rip rap, erosion control, fencing, seeding, sodding, and other incidental items, all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 658-377/423 at the following locations:
 - o 6000 Block of Waterbury Circle
 - o Southern Hills Drive between Park Avenue and Sioux Run
 - o 3308 Lincoln Avenue
 - o 3123 Jefferson Avenue
 - o 2907 Douglas Avenue
 - o 5315 Welker Avenue

- o 101 Locust Street
- Other locations directed by the Engineer.
- The estimated construction cost is \$725,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in early 2024 and be completed in the fall of 2024.
