# AGENDA HEADING:

Set date of public hearing on the proposed 3rd Amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Oak Park-Highland Park Urban Renewal Area.

# SYNOPSIS:

This roll call sets the date of public hearing on the proposed 3rd Amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Oak Park-Highland Park Urban Renewal Area for the December 4, 2023, City Council meeting. This Amendment updates Appendix A – Legal Description(s); updates Appendix B – Financial Condition Report; updates Appendix C – Approved Economic Development and Redevelopment Projects; and amends and updates Maps 1, 2, 3, and 4.

# FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no direct fiscal impact with the approval of the 3rd Amendment. The activities and projects that may be assisted by this urban renewal plan and tax increment revenues are now listed in the plan text and are subject to separate City Council action.

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- This item was cancelled from the November 6, 2023, City Council meeting to add clarifying language to the accompanying ordinance.
- A consultation meeting was held on October 19, 2023, with an invitation to representatives from Polk County, Des Moines Public Schools, Des Moines Area Community College, and Des Moines Area Regional Transit.
- The purpose of this 3rd Amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for the Oak Park-Highland Park Urban Renewal Area is to:
  - Amend and update Appendix A Legal Description(s) to:
    - Amend the legal description of the Oak Park-Highland Park Urban Renewal Area;
    - Remove the legal description for the Oak Park-Highland Park tax increment finance (TIF) District No. 3 due to termination; and
    - Include the legal description for the boundary of Oak Park-Highland Park TIF District No. 5.

- Amend and update Appendix B Financial Condition Report to reflect the new projects' projected assessments and incentives.
- Amend Appendix C Approved Economic Development and Redevelopment Projects to approve the provision of financial assistance from tax increment revenues in the Oak Park-Highland Park Urban Renewal Area for the following project:
  - 36 on 6th, LLC for the renovation of the existing building at 3614 6th Avenue for mixed-use residential and commercial uses.

And to reflect the termination of the development agreement for the following project:

- 3524 6th Avenue, LLC for the renovation of the existing building at 3524 6th Avenue for mixed-use residential and commercial uses.
- Amend and update Maps 1, 2, 3, and 4 to show the updated urban renewal area boundary, as well as the updates to the associated TIF districts.
