ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City will be switching from a named user licensing model, with a limit of 230 licenses, to a site licensing model. This will allow the City an unlimited number of users, mitigating the need to purchase additional licensing if staffing levels were to increase, new business processes are added to EPL requiring additional users, or additional departments begin using EPL for their business processes.
- The site license also decreases the annual maintenance and support costs for EPL by \$7,115.50.
