AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the Chapter 28E Agreement by and between the City of Des Moines, Iowa, and Warren County, Iowa, for a Public Improvement Project, Border Street Rehabilitation from 80th Avenue to 85th Avenue.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Chapter 28E Agreement between the City of Des Moines, Iowa, and Warren County, Iowa, for the coordination of funding for the design and construction for Border Street.

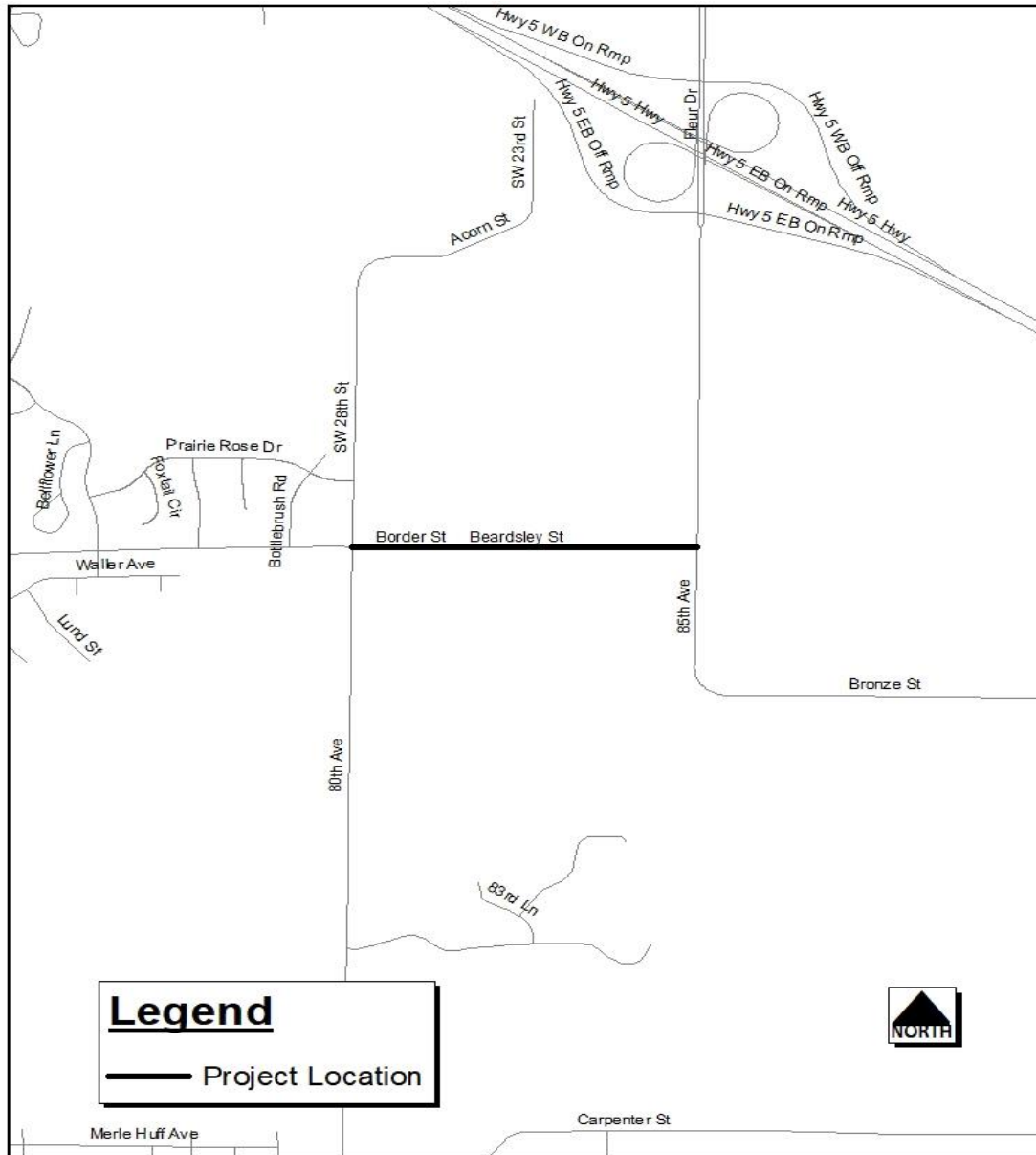
FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$200,000

Funding Source: Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page 119, Roadway Reconstruction, ST260, Road Use Tax Fund

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Warren County, Iowa, in coordination with the City of Des Moines, has developed a project to resurface Border Street from 80th Avenue to 85th Avenue. A portion of the roadway is in the boundary between the City of Des Moines Corporate Limits and Warren County Corporate Limits, requiring improvements to be developed in a coordinated manner. The City of Des Moines is the lead agency for this project and will be performing design and construction management. The proposed agreement requires Warren County and the City of Des Moines to share in the project costs based on the jurisdictional ownership of the roadway.
- The project will consist of full depth patching and the resurfacing of Border Street utilizing pavement scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay to improve the surface condition. The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2024.
- Warren County is tentatively scheduled to approve this 28E Agreement at its February 20, 2024 Board meeting.
