#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Ordering construction of the following: Locust Street Resurfacing from the Des Moines River to 9th Street - Receiving bids, (3-19-24), and Setting date of hearing, (4-15-24). (Construction Estimate - \$700,000).

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the resurfacing of Locust Street and Grand Avenue utilizing pavement scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay to improve the surface condition, and to extend the useful service life of the street.



## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Locust Street Resurfacing from the Des Moines River to 9th Street, Activity ID 06-2024-001. The improvement includes scarification, furnish and place HMA pavement, pavement markings, manhole adjustments, traffic control, and other incidental items in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 662-075/100 located on Locust Street from the Des Moines River to 9th Street and on Grand Avenue from the Des Moines River to 2nd Avenue in Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$700,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in spring 2024 and be completed in fall 2024. During the following festivals and events, the Contractor shall limit construction operations:
