AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: SW 56th Street Rehabilitation from Leland Avenue to Wolcott Circle - Receiving bids, (3-19-24), and Setting date of hearing, (4-15-24). (Construction Estimate - \$585,000).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the pavement rehabilitation, including milling, patching, and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay along Leland Avenue and SW 56th Street from Highway 28 to approximately 500 feet north of Wolcott Circle.

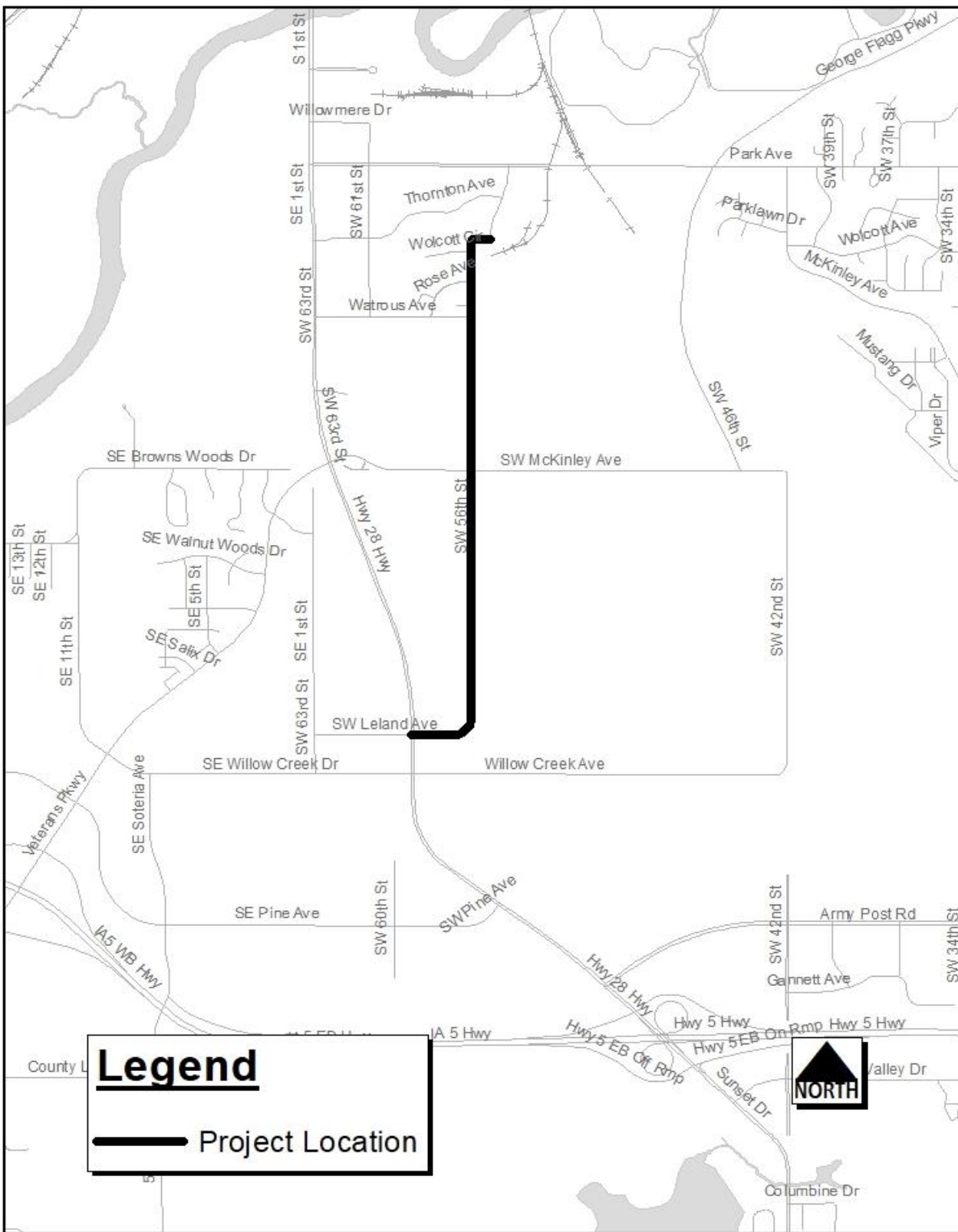

Amount: \$585,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page 170, LOSST Street Improvements, ST800, Local Option Sales and Services Tax (LOSST) Monies

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the SW 56th Street Rehabilitation from Leland Avenue to Wolcott Circle, Activity ID 06-2024-005. The improvement includes scarification, furnish and place HMA pavement, pavement markings, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, pavement removal, traffic control, and other incidental items, all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File No. 662- 043/068 located along Leland Avenue and SW 56th Street from Highway 28 to approximately 500 feet north of Wolcott Circle and other locations as directed by the City Engineer in Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$585,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to be completed by fall of 2024.
