Approving Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with I&S Group, Inc. for professional services for 16th Street Area Reconstruction and Trail Connection, for an amount not to exceed \$207,670.

SYNOPSIS:

Approving the PSA with I&S Group, Inc. (Lynn Bruns, CEO, 115 E. Hickory Street, Suite 300, Mankato, Minnesota 56001) for a total cost not to exceed \$207,670, based on hourly rates and reimbursable costs, to provide construction phase services for 16th Street Area Reconstruction and Trail Connection project.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On November 20, 2023, by Roll Call No. 23-1653, City Council held a hearing and awarded a construction contract to Shekar Engineering, PLC for the 16th Street Area Reconstruction and Trail Connection public improvement project for an amount of \$3,261,617.37.
- This project includes full pavement reconstruction with new pavement and curbs and gutters, new storm sewers and intakes, new sidewalks on at least one (1) side of the street, sanitary sewer improvements, and water distribution system improvements on the following streets:
 - o 16th Street from Euclid Avenue to Madison Avenue
 - o Seneca Avenue from 16th Street to 14th Street
 - o Madison Avenue from 16th Street to 15th Street
- A multi-use trail will also be constructed from the intersection of Madison Avenue and 15th Street, along the 3900 block of 16th Street and across City-owned property to the west to provide a neighborhood trail connection to the Neal Smith Trail along the Des Moines River.

- The design of this project was completed by City Engineering staff.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to start in the spring 2024 and be completed by the end of 2024.
- A Request for Proposals (RFP) for professional services for 2022-2024 On-Call Construction Inspection Services was issued and posted on the City's website. A selection committee of Engineering Department staff reviewed and rated the 10 proposals received in response to the RFP. I&S Group, Inc. was selected for this project based upon the selection criteria in the RFP and their project understanding and relevant project experience.
- City staff negotiated a PSA with I&S Group, Inc. for a total cost not to exceed \$207,670, based on
 hourly rates and reimbursable costs, to provide construction phase services for the project which
 includes construction administration and construction observation services.
