AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: SW 9th Street Rehabilitation from Emma Avenue to Leach Avenue - Receiving bids, (5-7-24), and Setting date of hearing, (6-3-24). (Construction Estimate - \$640,000).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project includes pavement rehabilitation of S.W. 9th Street from Emma Avenue to Leach Avenue, including scarification and removal of the top four (4)-inches of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement surface, patching defective sections of the existing concrete base, and HMA overlay with four (4)-inches of HMA pavement.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$640,000 City Engineer's Estimate

<u>Funding Source</u>: Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-2024 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page 170, Local Option Sales and Service Tax (LOSST) Street Improvements, ST800, LOSST Monies

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the SW 9th Street Rehabilitation from Emma Avenue to Leach Avenue, Activity ID 06-2024-008. The improvement includes street rehabilitation by milling the existing roadway, resurfacing with HMA, full depth Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement patching, pavement markings, and other incidental items, all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File No. 663- 053/069 located on S.W. 9th Street from Emma Avenue to Leach Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$640,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to be completed by fall of 2024.
