AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Locust Street Resurfacing from the Des Moines River to 9th Street: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Jeffry Rasmussen, President, \$475,583.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Locust Street Resurfacing from the Des Moines River to 9th Street and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the resurfacing of Locust Street and Grand Avenue utilizing pavement scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay to improve the surface condition, and to extend the useful service life of the street.

Amount: \$475,583 Construction Contract (\$700,000 City Engineer's Estimate)



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On March 4, 2024, under Roll Call No. 24-0306, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Locust Street Resurfacing from the Des Moines River to 9th Street. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Locust Street Resurfacing from the Des Moines River to 9th Street, Activity ID 06-2024-001. The improvement includes scarification, furnish and place HMA pavement, pavement markings, manhole adjustments, traffic control, and other incidental items in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 662-075/100 located on Locust Street from the Des Moines River to 9th Street and on Grand Avenue from the Des Moines River to 2nd Avenue.
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - o Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA Low Bid
 - o OMG Midwest, Inc. dba Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
 - o InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA

- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, IA, at 11:00 a.m. on March 19, 2024.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation (Jeffry Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA 50313) in the amount of \$475,583, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin as early as spring 2024 and be completed in fall 2024. The Contractor shall limit construction operations during the following festivals and events:
