AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2024 Sidewalk and Pedestrian Ramp Replacement Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as TK Concrete, Inc., Tony J. Ver Meer, President, \$505,150.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2024 Sidewalk and Pedestrian Ramp Replacement Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for a city-wide program to replace deteriorated City sidewalks, Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)-compliant sidewalk ramps, sidewalks damaged by City activities or by City trees in the parkway, and sidewalks for residents that qualify for the City's special assessment subsidy program.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On March 4, 2024, under Roll Call No. 24-0305, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2024 Sidewalk and Pedestrian Ramp Replacement Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2024 Sidewalk and Pedestrian Ramp Replacement Program, Activity ID 09-2024-003. The improvement includes reconstruction of brick sidewalks, Class A and Class B Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalks of varying thickness including all appurtenances, PCC ADA-compliant curb ramps, all in accordance with the contract documents at various locations directed by the City Engineer.
- One hundred sixty (160) locations have been identified for sidewalk or ramp replacement as part of this project and are identified in the figure below.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - TK Concrete, Inc., Pella, IA Low Bid
 - o Howser Concrete Unlimited, Jordan, MN
 - o MPS Engineers, P.C. dba Kingston Services, P.C., Des Moines, IA
 - o Ti-Zack Concrete, Inc., Le Center, MN
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, IA, at 11:00 a.m. on March 19, 2024.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by TK Concrete, Inc. (Tony J. Ver Meer, President, 1608 Fifield Road, Pella, IA 50219) in the amount of \$505,150, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to be completed by the end of 2024.
