SYNOPSIS:

Request approval to rent an aerial bucket truck for use by the Forestry Division of the Department of Public Works for approximately eight (8) months utilizing Sourcewell Purchasing Contract #062320 URI from United Rentals (3101 Spruce Street, Little Canada, MN 55117, Matthew J. Flannery, President) in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• An existing Forestry aerial lift exceeding replacement criteria was taken out of service due to the need for extensive repairs, and a replacement unit was ordered. The replacement unit is anticipated to be delivered in October 2024. In the interim there is an operational need to continue planned and scheduled forestry work requiring an aerial lift for tree trimming. Therefore, it is recommended to rent an available truck until a replacement unit is delivered and placed into service.
