SYNOPSIS:



Recommend approval of a License Agreement with Capital City Pride-Des Moines, Wes Mullins, Executive Director, 2643 Beaver Avenue, Unit 170, Des Moines, Iowa, 50211, for use of a portion of street right-of-way at East Grand Avenue and East 5th Street for a temporary art installation.

The proposed art project consists of painted sidewalks, tentatively titled “Pride Sidewalks,” in the Historic East Village at the intersection of East Grand Avenue and East 5th Street from May 7, 2024, to September 30, 2025.
