

ORDINANCE NO. 13,511

AN ORDINANCE vacating portions of the Mattern Avenue and East 19th Street rights-of-way in the vicinity of their intersection.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The following described portions of the Mattern Avenue and East 19th Street rights-of-way in the vicinity of their intersection, be and are hereby vacated:

All that part of East 19th Street right-of-way lying East of and adjoining Lots 1 through 12, Block 13, T.E. Brown's Official Plat of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 36, Township 79 North, Range 24 West of the 5th P.M., except the Northeast 40 Acres, and all that part of Mattern Avenue right-of-way lying East of the northerly extension of the East right-of-way line of DeWolf Street and West of the northerly extension of the East right-of-way line of East 19th Street, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
