

ORDINANCE NO. 13,606

AN ORDINANCE vacating portions of the right-of-way for Clay Street and an adjoining North/South Alley in the vicinity of Clay Street and S.W. 1st Street.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. The right-of-way in the vicinity of Clay Street and S.W. 1st Street, more specifically described below, be and is hereby vacated:

All that part of 66.0 foot Clay Street right-of-way lying North of and adjoining Block 8, South Fort Des Moines, an Official Plat and southeasterly of the Raccoon River; and all that part of 16.5 foot North/South alley right-of-way within Block 9 of said South Fort Des Moines and southeasterly of the Raccoon River, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. This vacation is subject to the reservation of right-of-way easements for all public utilities now in place with the right of entry for servicing same.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
