

ORDINANCE NO. 13,823

AN ORDINANCE vacating the North/South alley right-of-way in the north one-half of the block between 9th and 10th Streets, south of Locust Street.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the North/South alley right-of-way in the north one-half of the block between 9th and 10th Streets, south of Locust Street, more specifically described as follows, be and is hereby vacated:

All the North/South alley right-of-way lying West of and adjoining Lots 3 and 4, Block 5, West Fort Des Moines, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
