

ORDINANCE NO. 13,903

AN ORDINANCE vacating the east/west alley right-of-way 680' east of the north/south alley between Virginia Avenue and Pleasantview Drive, all west of S.W. 9th Street.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the following east/west alley right-of-way 680' east of the north/south alley between Virginia Avenue and Pleasantview Drive, all west of SW 9th Street, be and is hereby vacated:

The 12.0 feet East/west alley right-of-way lying North of and adjoining Lots 28 through 33, and the West 50.0 feet of Lot 34, Virginia Heights, an Official Plat, and lying North of and adjoining 30.0 foot Vacated railroad right-of-way lying West of and adjoining Lot 31, of said Virginia Heights, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. That this vacation is made with reservations of right-of-way easements for any public utilities now in place with the right of entry for servicing same.

Sec. 3. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
