

ORDINANCE NO. 13,924

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 13,870, passed October 16, 2000, by repealing Sections 114-361.01, 114-2614, 114-2625, 114-2712, 114-2733, 114-2868, 114-3466, 114-3867, 114-3872 and 114-3926 thereof and enacting new Sections 114-361.01, 114-2614, 114-2625, 114-2712, 114-2733, 114-2868, 114-3466, 114-3867, 114-3872 and 114-3926, relating to traffic and vehicles.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the
City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 13,870, passed October 16, 2000 is hereby amended by repealing Sections 114-361.01, 114-2614, 114-2625, 114-2712, 114-2733, 114-2868, 114-3466, 114-3867, 114-3872 and 114-3926 thereof and enacting new Sections 114-361.01, 114-2614, 114-2625, 114-2712, 114-2733, 114-2868, 114-3466, 114-3867, 114-3872 and 114-3926, relating to traffic and vehicles, as follows:

Sec. 114-361.01. Angle parking.

(a) The initiation of angle parking at any location where such parking is not in existence is prohibited except at the following locations:

(b) Angle parking shall be permitted to continue at locations where the distance between the painted centerline and the parking curblines is equal to or greater than the minimum requirement established by the following formula:

Minimum Width from Centerline

to Parking Curblines = $VAVE/400 \times 10' + 19'$

(c) The letters "VAVE" as used in the formula in subsection (b) of this section represent the average hourly volume of cars during the four highest hours of a day.

(d) The cost of installing and maintaining facilities for angle parking shall be borne by the abutting property owners, and if they or any of them shall fail to refuse to do so, the city reserves the right to withdraw the privilege of this method of parking.

(e) Nothing within this section shall prohibit parking by more than one motorcycle within one

parking space as
otherwise provided in
this chapter.

Southwest Third Street, on the west side,

Southwest Fourth Street, on the west side, from Vine Street to a point 50 feet south thereof, commercial loading zone.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the west side, from Market Street to a point 25 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the west side, from a point 90 feet south of Market Street to a point 60 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the east side, from Elm Street to a point 280 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the west side, from Thornton Avenue to Watrous Avenue, no parking any time.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the east side, from a point 50 feet north of Rose Avenue to a point 50 feet south of Rose Avenue, no parking any time.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the west side, from a point 500 feet south of Wall Avenue to Diehl Avenue, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-2712. Eleventh Place--Seneca Avenue to Aurora Avenue.

Eleventh Place, on the east side, from Seneca Avenue to Aurora Avenue, no parking any time.

Eleventh Place, on the west side, from Madison Avenue to a point 60 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

**Sec. 114-2733. Southwest Twelfth Street--
Gray Street to Havens Avenue.**

Southwest Twelfth Street, on the east side, from Davis Avenue to Elder Lane, no parking any time.

Southwest Twelfth Street, on the west side, from Davis Avenue to Watrous Avenue, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Southwest Twelfth Street, on the west side, from Watrous Avenue to a point 75 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Twelfth Street, on the west side, from Elder Lane to a point 75 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Twelfth Street, on the west side, from McKinley Avenue to Hackley Avenue, no parking any time.

Southwest Twelfth Street, on the east side, from Porter Avenue to Army Post Road, no parking any time.

Southwest Twelfth Street, on the west side, from Highview Drive to a point 50 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Twelfth Street, on the west side, from a point 50 feet north of Payton Avenue to a point 50 feet south of Payton Avenue, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on the west side, from Grand Avenue to a point 150 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on the west side, from a point 150 feet south of Grand Avenue to a point 60 feet south thereof, commercial loading zone.

Thirty-first Street, on the west side, from a point 210 feet south of Grand Avenue to a point 210 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on the west side, from a point 420 feet south of Grand Avenue to a point 550 feet south thereof, no parking 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Thirty-first Street, on the west side, from Grand Avenue to Ingersoll Avenue, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on the east side, from Ingersoll Avenue to a point 190 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on both sides, from Ingersoll Avenue to a point 250 feet north of Pleasant Street, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on both sides, from a point 250 feet north of Pleasant Street to a point 200 feet north thereof, no stopping or standing.

Thirty-first Street, on both sides, from a point 450 feet north of Pleasant Street to University Avenue, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on the west side, from University Avenue to Forest Avenue, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on the east side, from University Avenue to a point 70 feet north thereof, two-hour parking, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Thirty-first Street, on the east side, from 50 feet south of Carpenter Avenue to a point 50 feet north of Carpenter Avenue, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on the east side, from Forest Avenue to a point 165 feet north of College Avenue, no parking any time.

Thirty-first Street, on the east side, from Victoria Drive to Lincoln Avenue, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-3466. Market Street--Southwest First Street to Southwest Sixth Street.

Market Street, on the south side, from a point 135 feet west of Southwest First Street to a point forty feet west thereof, loading zone.

Market Street, on the north side, from Southwest First Street to Southwest Third Street, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Market Street, on the south side, from Southwest Third Street, to a point 25 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Market Street, on the south side, from Southwest Fourth Street, to a point 60 feet east thereof, no parking any time.

Market Street, on the south side, from Southwest Fourth Street, to a point 25 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Market Street, on the north side, from Southwest Fourth Street, to a point 25 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Market Street, on the south side, from Southwest Fifth Street to a point 25 feet east thereof, no parking any time.

Market Street, on the north side, from a point 165 feet west of Southwest Fourth Street to a point 40 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Market Street, on the north side, from Southwest Fifth Street to a point 25 feet east thereof, no parking any time.

Market Street, on both sides, from Southwest Fifth Street to Southwest Sixth Street, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-3867. Southwest Third Street--Vine Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway.

Southwest Third Street, on the east side, from Vine Street to a point 25 feet north of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Sec. 114-3872. Southwest Fourth Street--Vine Street to Market Street.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the west side, from a point 50 feet south of Vine Street to a point 25 feet north of Market Street, two-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the east side, from a point 250 feet south of Vine Street to a point 25 feet north of Market Street, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the west side, from a point 25 feet south of Market Street to a point 65 feet south thereof, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Southwest Fourth Street, on the east side, from a point 75 feet south of Vine Street to a point 140 feet south thereof, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Sec. 114-3926. Market Street--Southwest First Street to Southwest Fourth Street.

Market Street, on the south side, from Southwest First Street to a point 135 feet west thereof, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Market Street, on the north side, from Southwest Third Street to Southwest Fourth Street, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Market Street, on the south side, from a point 25 feet west of Southwest Third Street to a point 60 feet east of Southwest Fourth Street, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Market Street, on the south side, from a point 25 feet west of Southwest Fourth Street, to a point 25 feet east of Southwest Fifth Street, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Market Street, on the north side, from a point 25 feet west of Southwest Fourth Street, to a point 140 feet west thereof, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Market Street, on the north side, from a point 205 feet west of Southwest Fourth Street, to a point 25 feet east of Southwest Fifth Street, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
