

ORDINANCE NO. 14,063

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 13,887, passed November 20, 2000, and Ordinance No. 13,929, passed March 12, 2001, by repealing Sections 74-177, 74-181, 74,182 and 74-183 thereof and enacting new Sections 74-177, 74-181, 74-182 and 74-183, relating to fees at the Botanical Center, golf courses, lodge park shelter and other park rentals, and aquatic centers, swimming pools and marina.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 13,887, passed November 20, 2000, and Ordinance No. 13,929, passed March 12, 2001, is hereby amended by repealing Sections 74-177, 74-181, 74,182 and 74-183 thereof and enacting new Sections 74-177, 74-181, 74-182 and 74-183, relating to fees at the Botanical Center, golf courses, lodge park shelter and other park rentals, and aquatic centers, swimming pools and marina, as follows:

Sec. 74-177. Botanical Center space rental and admission fees.

(a) *Definitions.* The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this section, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this subsection, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

Weekdays are Monday through Thursday.

Weekends are Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

(b) *Greens fees.* The golf course greens fees listed in subsections (b) (1) and (2) of this section are total costs which include irrigation, reservation, and tax. Greens fees for golf courses shall be as follows:
