

ORDINANCE NO. 14,126

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 13,893, passed December 4, 2000, by repealing Sections 114-2603, 114-2744, 114-2841 and 114-3443 thereof and enacting new Sections 114-2603, 114-2744, 114-2841 and 114-3443, relating to traffic regulation changes.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 13,893, passed December 4, 2000, is hereby amended by repealing Sections 114-2603, 114-2744, 114-2841 and 114-3443 thereof and enacting new Sections 114-2603, 114-2744, 114-2841 and 114-3443, relating to traffic regulation changes, as follows:

Sec. 114-2603. Third Street--Vine Street to Court Avenue.

Third Street, on the west side, from Vine Street to a point 125 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

Third Street, on the west side, from a point 125 feet north of Vine Street to a point 25 feet north thereof, is designated a handicapped loading zone and is subject to the same prohibitions as are found in subsection 114-616(a) and in section 114-406 of this chapter.

Third Street, on the west side, from a point 150 feet north of Vine Street to a point 25 feet north thereof, commercial loading zone.

Third Street, on the west side, from a point 175 feet north of Vine Street to a point 225 feet south of Court Avenue, no parking any time.

Third Street, on the east side, from Vine Street to a point 50 feet north thereof, commercial loading zone.

Third Street, on the east side, from Court Avenue to a point 80 feet south thereof, taxicab stand 6:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m.

Third Street, on the east side, from Court Avenue to a point 80 feet south thereof, commercial loading zone.

Third Street, on the east side, from a point 125 feet south of Court Avenue to a point 25 feet south thereof, commercial loading zone.

**Sec. 114-2744. Southwest Thirteenth Street--
Pleasantview Drive to Havens Avenue.**

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the west side, from Pleasantview Drive to Carrie Avenue, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the east side, from Park Avenue to a point 60 feet north thereof, no parking any time.
Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the east side, from Watrous Avenue to a point 50 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the west side, from McKinley Avenue to a point 50 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the east side, from McKinley Avenue to Hackley Avenue, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the west side, from Hackley Avenue to a point 300 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the west side, from Frazier Avenue to Kenyon Avenue, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the east side, from Army Post Road to a point 35 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the west side, from Leland Avenue to a point 50 feet south of Army Post road, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the west side, from a point 50 feet north of Wade Street to a point 50 feet south of Wade Street, no parking any time.

Southwest Thirteenth Street, on the east side, from Army Post Road to Havens Avenue, no parking any time.

**Sec. 114-2841. East Twenty-seventh Court--
Maple Street to East Jefferson Avenue.**

East Twenty-seventh Court, on the east side, from Maple Street to East University Avenue, no parking any time.

East Twenty-seventh Court, on the west side, from East University Avenue to a point 50 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

East Twenty-seventh Court, on the east side, from East University Avenue to East Jefferson Avenue, no parking any time.

East Twenty-seventh Court, on the west side, from a point 230 feet south of Easton Boulevard to a point 30 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

**Sec. 114-3443. Lynner Drive--Martin Luther
King, Jr. Parkway to Aurora Avenue.**

Lynner Drive, on the north side, from Martin Luther King, Jr. Parkway to Madison Avenue, no parking any time.

Lynner Drive, on the south side, from a point 50 feet east of Oakshire Road to a

point 50 feet west of Oakshire Road, no parking any time.

Lynner Drive, on the east side, from Madison Avenue to Aurora Avenue, no parking any time.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
