

ORDINANCE NO. 14,153

AN ORDINANCE vacating the East Railroad Avenue right-of-way between S.E. 14<sup>th</sup> Court and S.E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the following East Railroad Avenue right-of-way between S.E. 14<sup>th</sup> Court and S.E. 15<sup>th</sup> Street, be and is hereby vacated:

South 50.0 foot of the North 75.0 foot of East Railroad Avenue (also known as Railroad Avenue) right-of-way lying South of and adjoining Lots 137 and 138, Grays Subdivision of Blocks 50 and 62, Brooks & Company Addition and the South 50.0 foot of the North 75.0 foot of East Railroad Avenue (also known as Railroad Avenue) right-of-way lying South of and adjoining Vacated North/South alley right-of-way between said Lots 137 and 138, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. That this vacation is made with reservations of right-of-way easements for any public utilities now in place with the right of entry for servicing same.

Sec. 3. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause certified copies of this ordinance and proof of publication thereof together with proof of publication of the notice of the public hearing on this matter to be properly filed in the office of the Recorder of Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
