

ORDINANCE NO. 14,217

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 13,887, passed November 20, 2000, and by Ordinance No. 13,929, passed March 12, 2001, and Ordinance No. 13,939, passed April 16, 2001, and Ordinance No. 14,063, passed March 18, 2002, and Ordinance No. 14,192, passed December 18, 2002, and Ordinance No. 14,193, passed December 18, 2002, by amending Sections 74-177, 74-182, 74-183, and 74-184 and repealing Section 74-174, relating to Botanical Center fees, park shelter fees, aquatic center fees and zoo fees.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 13,887, passed November 20, 2000, and by Ordinance No. 13,929, passed March 12, 2001, and Ordinance No. 13,939, passed April 16, 2001, and Ordinance No. 14,063, passed March 18, 2002, and Ordinance No. 14,192, passed December 18, 2002, and Ordinance No. 14,193, passed December 18, 2002, by amending Sections 74-177, 74-182, 74-183, and 74-184 and repealing Section 74-174, relating to Botanical Center fees, park shelter fees, aquatic center fees and zoo fees, as follows:
