

ORDINANCE NO. 15,293

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Section 74-97, relating to fishing.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Section 74-97 relating to fishing, as follows:

Sec. 74-97. Lakes and ponds.

No person shall throw or place any foreign or waste substance in any lake, wading pool or swimming beach in any public park. Boats are not permitted in lakes and ponds, with the exception of Gray's Lake, without the permission of the park and recreation director. No person shall fish from or dangle any object from the Gray's Lake watercraft rental dock, the Gray's Lake swimming beach, or the Gray's Lake pedestrian bridge.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
