

## ORDINANCE NO. 15,341

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Sections 114-1465 and 114-3341 and by adding and enacting a new Section 114-1546.001, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Sections 114-1465 and 114-3341 and by adding and enacting a new Section 114-1546.001, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations, as follows:

### **Sec. 114-1465. Indianola Avenue.**

Indianola Avenue and Southeast First Street, traffic control signal.  
Indianola Avenue and Hartford Avenue, traffic control signal.  
Indianola Avenue and Southeast Sixth Street, traffic control signal.  
Indianola Avenue and East Park Avenue, traffic control signal.  
Indianola Avenue and Southeast Fourteenth Street, traffic control signal.  
Indianola Avenue and Evergreen Avenue, traffic control signal.  
Indianola Avenue and East Watrous Avenue, traffic control signal.  
Indianola Avenue and East McKinley Avenue, traffic control signal.  
Indianola Avenue and Easter Lake Drive, traffic control signal.

### **Sec. 114-1546.001. Martin Luther King Jr Parkway**

Martin Luther King Jr Parkway, on the east side, at a point 140 feet north of Jefferson Avenue, pedestrian signal.

Martin Luther King Jr Parkway, on the east side, at a point 200 feet north of Allison Avenue, pedestrian signal.

### **Sec. 114-3341. Indianola Avenue--Jackson Avenue to south city limits.**

Indianola Avenue, on the westerly side, from Jackson Avenue to a point 100 feet southeasterly of Edison Avenue, no parking any time.

Indianola Avenue, on the westerly side, from a point 100 feet southeasterly of Edison Avenue to a point 220 feet southeasterly thereof, bus loading and unloading 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. school days.

Indianola Avenue, on the westerly side, from a point 320 feet southeasterly of Edison Avenue to Southeast Seventh Street, no parking any time.

Indianola Avenue, on the westerly side, from Southeast Seventh Street to a point 200 feet southeasterly thereof, bus loading and unloading 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. school days.

Indianola Avenue, on the westerly side, from a point 200 feet southeasterly of Southeast Seventh Street to Southeast Eighth Street, no stopping or standing.

Indianola Avenue, on the westerly side, from Southeast Eighth Street to East Rose Avenue, no parking any time.

Indianola Avenue, on the westerly side, from East Rose Avenue to a point 340 feet east of Southeast Sixteenth Court, no stopping or standing.

Indianola Avenue, on the western side, from a point 340 feet east of Southeast Sixteenth Court to Southridge Boulevard, no parking any time.

Indianola Avenue, on the easterly side, from Jackson Avenue to Southeast Seventh Street, no parking any time.

Indianola Avenue, on the easterly side, from Southeast Seventh Street to Southeast Eighth Street, no stopping or standing.

Indianola Avenue, on the easterly side, from Southeast Eighth Street to a point 1115 feet southeasterly of Evergreen Avenue, no parking any time.

Indianola Avenue, on the easterly side, starting at a point 1115 feet southeasterly of Evergreen Avenue to a point of intersection with the northeasterly projection of the northerly line of East Watrous Avenue thereof, no stopping or standing.

Indianola Avenue, on the easterly side, starting at a point of intersection with the northeasterly projection of the southerly line of East Watrous Avenue thence easterly 475 feet thereof, school passenger loading and unloading, 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. school days; no parking at all other times.

Indianola Avenue, on the easterly side, from a point 475 feet south of East Watrous Avenue to Southridge Boulevard, no parking any time.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
