AN ORDINANCE vacating the residential portion of the North/South Alley between East 9th Street and Wright Street, extending from East Hull Avenue to East Tiffin Avenue.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated;




