WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines is entitled to one voting member on the Warren County E911 Joint Service Board; and



Iowa Code

605-10.3 (1) Membership

- a. Each political subdivision having a public safety agency serving territory within Warren County is entitled to one voting member.
- b. Private safety agency serving territory within Warren County is entitled to one non-voting member.
- c. Public / Private safety agencies headquartered outside but operating within Warren County are entitled to membership and voting privileges as described in 1 and 2.
- d. Political subdivisions which does not operate a public safety agencies, but contracts service is not entitled to membership, however the contractor is entitled to membership.
- e. Joint E911 service board elects a chairperson and co-chairperson.
