AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 14,093 passed June 3, 2002, and Ordinance 14,177 passed December 16, 2002, and Ordinance No. 14,213 passed March 10, 2003, by amending Section 46-1(c)(27) thereof, relating to permits required in Chapter 46, Fire Prevention and Protection.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, and amended by Ordinance No. 14,093 passed June 3, 2002, and Ordinance 14,177 passed December 16, 2002, and Ordinance No. 14,213 passed March 10, 2003, is hereby amended by amending Section 46-1(c)(27) thereof, relating to permits required in Chapter 46, Fire Prevention and Protection, as follows:

Sec. 46-1. Permits required.

- (c) Yearly operational permits shall be required for each of the following facilities or uses, and the fee for each such installation or use shall be the amount established in the schedule of fees adopted by the city council by resolution:
 - (27) Refrigerant equipment. To operate a refrigeration unit or system containing any amount of group 2 or 3 refrigerant or those with group 1 refrigerant and a compressor rating of 100 horsepower or more (see chapter 6 of the fire code) having a refrigerant circuit containing more than 220 pounds (100 kg) of group Al or 30 pounds (14 kg) of any other group refrigerant.
- Sec. 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
