**APPROVING JOINT PUBLIC SERVICE 28E AGREEMENT WITH POLK COUNTY,
ANKENY, JOHNSTON AND POLK CITY CONCERNING PROPOSED N.W.26TH STREET
INTERCHANGE AT I-80/35**

WHEREAS, Polk County has proposed the development of the NW 26th Street Interchange/MLK Parkway; and

WHEREAS, this project is currently included in the Des Moines Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) 2030 Long Range Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, federal funding was recently received for completion of the Interchange Justification Report and Environmental Impact Study relating to this project; and

WHEREAS, Polk County desires that the cities which will be affected by this project enter into a 28E agreement; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the proposed 28E agreement the City of Des Moines would agree to support the project, would have an opportunity to participate in meetings regarding the project, and would have the right to review and approve the design documents for the elements of the project improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, that the Joint Public Service 28E Agreement Show of Support between Polk County, and the cities of Ankeny, Des Moines, Johnston, and Polk City, Iowa, be and it is hereby approved, and that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest, respectively, said Agreement for and on behalf of the City of Des Moines.
