I am submitting this report pursuant to Council's request for Police reports when Court Avenue bars come up for renewal. On the September 28 agenda you will find a renewal request for Pelican Bar, 208 3rd Street. Thomas (Tommy) Mauro has requested renewal of his Class C Liquor License with a **new** request for Outdoor Service Privilege for their previously approved sidewalk café, which was approved on May 18th.

This additional Outdoor Service Privilege will allow them to serve and sell liquor/beer/wine through their patio window. Currently, his license only allows beer and wine to be sold inside and then carried outside to the sidewalk cafe.

Below is a summary of police events at the Pelican Bar. A representative of the vice unit will be at the council meeting to answer any questions.

Police Report regarding Pelican Bar

With the exception of case# 09-16662 where the owner, Thomas Mauro was arrested for Interference Causing Injury to an Officer (Ballantini), Public Consumption, and a couple of warrants for Simple Assault, the bar has been relatively quiet over the past year.

We received no complaints over the past year.

On three separate occasions throughout the year, the Vice unit conducted alcohol compliance checks at 208 3rd. With the exception of the compliance check on 28MAY09 which resulted in the above arrest of Mr. Mauro, there were no additional violations. In addition to these three complaints checks, NCS officers were assigned the Court Avenue Bar area for a couple of weeks during the middle of July. Additional officers were requested by the Chief following the beating incident in the 100 block of 3rd, close to the 101 Lounge. During that time, numerous checks were done at the Pelican Bar as well as all of the other Liquor establishments in the Court Avenue district. We had no additional violations with the Pelican during the extra patrol activity.

Running "Calls for Service", we had a total of 25 since 09/25/2008 last year. Most of these calls were minor in nature, i.e. Public Intox, Medics, Disputes, Suspicious persons, etc.

From the 25 calls, 8 cases were made. Just to be fair, 3 of the Intox cases listed below were not in the Pelican Bar rather the street in front, the 200 block of 2nd.

- 6 –Public Intoxication
- 1 – Disorderly Conduct
- 1 - Case, 09-16662, (Owner arrested)
