Dear Mayor Cownie and Members of the City Council:



During the Iowa State Fair there are no sidewalks and the cars are parked on one side of the street leaving only the street to handle both the walking traffic of children and adults at the same time that the two way traffic of cars at the same time in the same place. It has been a miracle that no children or adults have been hit even though there have been close calls.

Today I have stopped at the homes who were home and found there was a great deal of "Thank You" for seeking this Sidewalk Petition for the safety of children who have to walk in the street coming home and going to school. One mother commented this would help keep the children from wanting to play in the street.

There were three homes where no one was home. One had said earlier that he would sign the petition but they are gone today on a cross country semi-drive. The other two were not home. There were two who did not sign because they felt that sidewalk was not needed. However 85% of the homes that did not have a sidewalk saw the advantage and were happy to sign and looked forward to its implementation.
