AN ORDINANCE vacating Maple Street between East 20th Court and the Union Pacific Railroad.

WHEREAS, all prior requirements of law pertaining to the vacation of public right-of-way have been fully observed; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public right-of-way herein described be vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That Maple Street between East 20<sup>th</sup> Court and Union Pacific Railroad, more specifically described as follows, be and is hereby vacated.

All the Maple Street right-of-way (formerly known as Claypool Avenue, changed by Ordinance No. 1560, passed December 4, 1908), lying South of and adjoining Lot 1, and lying South of and adjoining the West 20.0 feet of Lot 2, Block 13, Sunnyside Addition, an Official Plat, all now included in and forming a part of the City of Des Moines, Polk County, Iowa.

Sec. 2. The City of Des Moines hereby reserves an easement upon the property described above for the continued use and maintenance of any utilities now in place, with the right of entry for servicing same.


