

Mayor and Council,

The City of Clive has been a member of the Homeland Security 28E Agreement (Agreement) since its inception. It has been determined that some services provided by Des Moines are a duplication of services provided through collaboration with our neighboring cities and the State of Iowa. As such, the City of Clive is now requesting Des Moines' concurrence to allow immediate withdraw from the Agreement.

Clive, along with our neighboring cities of Urbandale and West Des Moines are dispatched by Westcom. Urbandale and West Des Moines recently ceased participating in the Agreement and instead are collaborating with the State of Iowa for WMD, CBRNE, and Bomb Squad services. With our extensive shared boundaries with those cities and our joint Westcom dispatching facility, an element of confusion could occur when determining which agency is to be called for service. For situations such as these, confusion needs to be, at the very least, limited if not eliminated.

Due to the above, the City of Clive is requesting that Des Moines release it from the Agreement at this time instead of the Agreement's sunset date of June 30, 2015. Our cities have and continue to benefit from many collaborative efforts and we anticipate working with you on future mutually beneficial projects. Des Moines' provision of homeland security services to our community has been appreciated but due to changing needs and options which are now available, we are at a point where we need to pursue other alternatives. Thank you for your consideration and I look forward to your decision.
