**APPROVAL OF A CDBG PROJECT AGREEMENT WITH
6TH AVENUE CORRIDOR, INC. FOR
REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN THE 6TH AVENUE CORRIDOR AREA**

WHEREAS, the blighted and/or vacant structures from Franklin Avenue to Forest Avenue along 6th Avenue, locally known as 1605, 1609, 1619 and 1623 6th Avenue (City Hall – Grocery), 1511, 1517 and 1521 6th Avenue (Hansen House), and 1710 and 1714 6th Avenue (Urban Dreams) (herein collectively “Properties”), have been determined to pose an impediment to the redevelopment of the 6th Avenue Corridor; and

WHEREAS, the redevelopment of one or more of the Properties was identified as a top priority in the planning process for the 6th Avenue Corridor, and by the Neighborhood Development Division of the City’s Community Development Department; and

WHEREAS, 6th Avenue Corridor, Inc. proposes to redevelop one or more of the Properties, following acquisition and demolition of the existing structure(s), and to either complete the redevelopment project itself or, with City staff, select a suitable for-profit or non-profit developer to purchase the property from 6th Avenue Corridor, Inc., subject to affordability covenants and with purchase proceeds returned to the City as project income, for development of future affordable multi-family housing projects on the applicable Properties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Des Moines has allocated \$318,000 of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding for fiscal year 2014 for Neighborhood Revitalization Plan Implementation; and

WHEREAS, the City proposes to utilize \$150,000 of such CDBG funding to assist 6th Avenue Corridor, Inc. in the above-described project for redevelopment of the blighted property and for low-rent housing purposes, pursuant to the Neighborhood Revitalization Plan; and

WHEREAS, 6th Avenue Corridor, Inc.’s proposed project for redevelopment of one or more of the Properties is set forth in a CDBG Project Agreement between the City and 6th Avenue Corridor, Inc., on file in the office of the City Clerk, and, due to the nature and amount of such Agreement, the Agreement is being presented to City Council for consideration and approval.
