AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code Regarding Traffic Regulation Changes as follows:

- A. Removal of two (2) parking meters on the east side of 12th Street north of Cherry Street.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the staff recommendations, including first reading of the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Minor costs for signing modifications.

Funding Source: 2014-2015 Operating Budget, Page 74 Engineering Department Traffic & Transportation – Sign Installation and Maintenance

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. At the request of a citizen, the Traffic & Transportation Division has reviewed the placement of two (2) parking meters on the east side of 12th Street, north of Cherry Street. At times of high traffic volumes, the concern was that one (1) or more parked cars in the northbound curb lane would impede northbound traffic entering the downtown on 12th Street.

The following recommended ordinance change will remove two (2) metered parking spaces and change the area to no parking anytime.

Sec. 114-3983. Twelfth Street--Cherry Street to Mulberry Street.

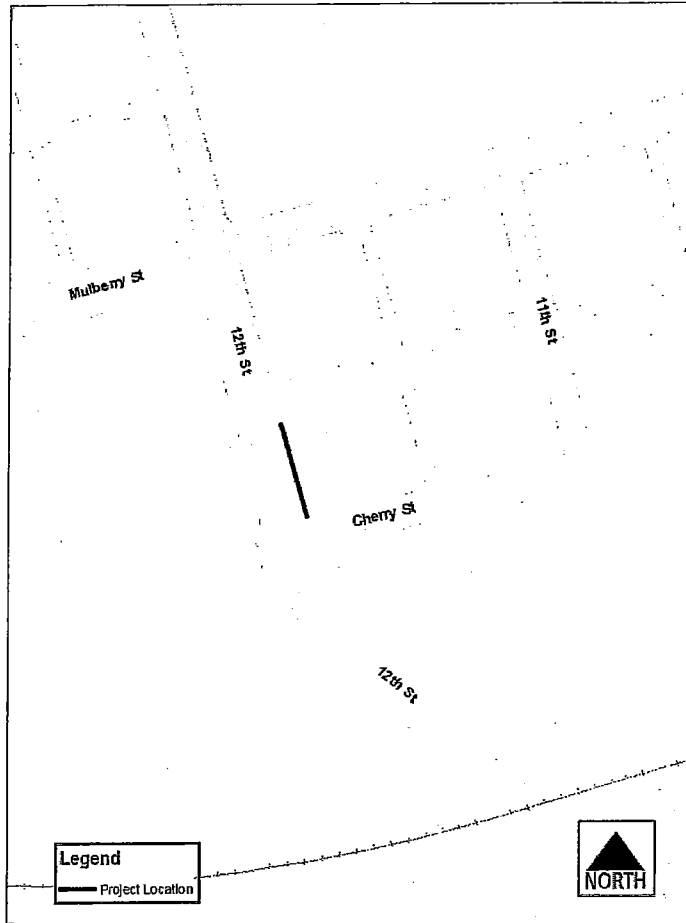
Twelfth Street, on the east side, from a point 45 160 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 25 feet south of Mulberry Street, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Sec. 114-2723. Twelfth Street--Cherry Street to Mulberry Street.

Twelfth Street, on the east side, from Cherry Street to a point 40 160 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

~~Twelfth Street, on the east side, from a point 40 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 40 feet north thereof, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.~~

~~Twelfth Street, on the east side, from a point 80 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 65 feet north thereof, no parking any time.~~

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, by amending Sections 114-2723 and 114-3983, relating to traffic and vehicle regulations.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa:

Section 1. That the Municipal Code of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, 2000, adopted by Ordinance No. 13,827, passed June 5, 2000, as heretofore amended, is hereby amended by amending Sections 114-2723 and 114-3983 relating to traffic and vehicle regulations, as follows:

Sec. 114-2723. Twelfth Street--Cherry Street to Mulberry Street.

Twelfth Street, on the east side, from Cherry Street to a point ~~40~~ 160 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

~~Twelfth Street, on the east side, from a point 40 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 40 feet north thereof, no parking 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.~~

Twelfth Street, on the east side, from Mulberry Street to a point 25 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Twelfth Street, on the west side, from a point 25 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 25 feet south of Mulberry Street, no parking 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

~~Twelfth Street, on the east side, from a point 80 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 65 feet north thereof, no parking any time.~~

Twelfth Street, on the west side, from Cherry Street to a point 25 feet north thereof, no parking any time.

Twelfth Street, on the west side, from Mulberry Street to a point 25 feet south thereof, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-3983. Twelfth Street--Cherry Street to Mulberry Street.

Twelfth Street, on the east side, from a point ~~145~~ 160 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 25 feet south of Mulberry Street, ten-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Twelfth Street, on the west side, from a point 25 feet north of Cherry Street to a point 25 feet south of Mulberry Street, four-hour meters, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Twelfth Street, on the west side, parking meter 12-110, is designated a four-hour meter, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., and is designated a handicapped parking space and is subject to the same prohibition as is found in subsection 114-616(a) of this chapter.
