WHEREAS, the Police Department has requested the Finance Department's Procurement Division issue a purchase order for ammunition for training and duty purposes; and

WHEREAS, the ammunition is being procured through the competitive bidding process using State of Iowa Master Agreement 19090A; and

WHEREAS, Municipal Code section 2-726 (k) provides for the procurement of goods and/or services from contracts established by the State of Iowa Department of Administrative Services, the Iowa Department of Transportation, or the Iowa Communications Network pursuant to procedures established by Iowa Code Chapter 8A and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, without conforming to the competitive bidding requirements of the Procurement Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the ammunition is being purchased from Kiesler Police Supply, Inc., 2802 Sable Mill Rd., Jeffersonville, Indiana 47130, (Chief Executive Officer Doug Kiesler) in the amount of \$99,029.76; and

WHEREAS, \$37,349.06 of the funding is from PD220352/Personnel & Training, and \$61,680.70 of the funding is available from PD221366/Tactical..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, accepts and approves the purchase of ammunition from Kiesler Police Supply, Inc. in the amount of \$99,029.76, using State of Iowa Master Agreement 19090A.
