HEARING AND ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT TO THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2021

WHEREAS, an amendment to the City's annual budget for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 is necessary to reflect changing estimates of revenue and expenditure appropriations relating to the COVID-19 outbreak, of revenue and expenditure appropriations relating to amounts available from revenues other than property taxation including federal COVD-19 relief grants, of adjustments in expenditures across all programs including capital improvement program budgets to recognize delays, shifts and reductions to various projects; and transfers between funds and between programs; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Chapter 384, Code of Iowa, require a public hearing on the amendment to the City's annual budget for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2021 by Roll Call No. 20-1569, the City Council set the public hearing to consider the amendment to the City's annual budget for the current fiscal year for October 19, 2020 at 5:00 o'clock p.m. in the 2nd Floor, MSC Board Room in the Richard A. Clark Municipal Services Center and public notice of such hearing and the electronic public access to such hearing has been published as provided by law in the Des Moines Register; and

WHEREAS, those residents and taxpayers of the City interested in the amendment to the City's annual budget for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, have been given an opportunity to present to the City Council objections to any part of the amended budget and arguments in favor of any part of the amended budget at this public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that:

1. Upon due consideration of all views, comments, objections to and arguments in favor of any part of the budget amendment and change presented by City residents and taxpayers, the public hearing on the amendment to the City of Des Moines annual budget for the current fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 is hereby closed.
