HOLD HEARING FOR APPROVAL OF DOCUMENTS FOR CONVEYANCE OF EXCESS CITY-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 620 DOUGLAS AVENUE AND 994 25TH STREET TO INVEST DSM, INC. FOR \$33,500

WHEREAS, the properties located at 620 Douglas Avenue and 994 25th Street were acquired and all structures were removed as part of the 2018 Limited Voluntary Flood Buyout project; and

WHEREAS, City Engineering, Public Works, and Community Development staff have determined that the above properties are located outside of the 500-year floodplain and can be sold for redevelopment; and

WHEREAS, Invest DSM, Inc., a non-profit collaboration between the City of Des Moines and Polk County, Iowa focusing on neighborhood revitalization programs in targeted neighborhoods within Des Moines, has offered to the City of Des Moines (“City”) the purchase price of \$11,500 for the purchase of 620 Douglas Avenue, and \$22,000 for the purchase of 994 25th Street, Des Moines, Iowa (hereinafter collectively “Property”), for residential redevelopment with single family homes, subject to the reservation of any necessary easements for all existing utilities in place until such time that they are abandoned or relocated, which price reflects the fair market value of the Property as determined by the City’s Real Estate Division; and

WHEREAS, there is no known current or future public need for the Property proposed to be conveyed, and the City will not be inconvenienced by the conveyance of said Property; and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2021 by Roll Call No. 21-0375, it was duly resolved by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, that the proposed conveyance be set for hearing on March 22, 2021, at 5:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, Richard A. Clark Municipal Service Center, 1551 E. Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, Des Moines, Iowa, and given Mayor Cownie’s March 15, 2020 Proclamation, as amended, prohibiting indoor gatherings of ten or more persons on public property, Section One of the Governor’s February 5, 2021 Proclamation strongly encouraging vulnerable Iowans to limit participation in gatherings of any size and any purpose during the COVID19 outbreak, and further given Section 108 of the Governor’s February 5, 2021 Proclamation suspending the regulatory provisions of Iowa Code §§ 21.8, 26.12, and 414.12, or any other statute imposing a requirement to hold a public meeting or hearing, and further given the City Manager’s decision to delay the opening of City buildings to the public due to the recent upwards spikes of positive COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations in Polk County and the need to maintain safety; it is impossible and impractical to have physical public access to the meeting location and the meeting will be conducted electronically with electronic and telephonic public access to the meeting location; and

WHEREAS, due notice of said proposal to convey the Property was given to all necessary parties as provided by law, setting forth the time and place for hearing on said proposal, including how to participate electronically and telephonically; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with City Council direction, those interested in the proposed conveyance, both for and against, have been given an opportunity to be heard with respect thereto and have presented their views to the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Des Moines, Iowa, as follows:

1. Upon due consideration of the facts and statements of interested persons, any and all objections to the proposed conveyance of excess City property locally known as 620 Douglas Avenue and 994 25th Street Des Moines, Iowa, as described herein, are hereby overruled and the hearing is closed.
2. There is no public need or benefit for the excess City-owned property proposed to be conveyed, and the public would not be inconvenienced by reason of the conveyance of the excess City property locally known as 620 Douglas Avenue and 994 25th Street Des Moines, Iowa, legally described as follows, to Invest DSM, Inc. for \$33,500.00, and said conveyance is hereby approved, subject to reservation of easements for all existing utilities in place, until such time that they are abandoned or relocated:

Purchase Price: \$22,000

LOT 199, UNIVERSITY LAND COMPANY'S FIRST ADDITION TO THE CITY OF DES MOINES, OFFICIAL PLAT, ALL NOW INCLUDED IN AND FORMING A PART OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, POLK COUNTY, IOWA, AND CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 0.18 ACRES (7,627 SQUARE FEET).

620 Douglas Avenue

Purchase Price: \$11,500

LOT 6, BLOCK 1, OAK PARK, OFFICIAL PLAT, ALL NOW INCLUDED IN AND FORMING A PART OF THE CITY OF DES MOINES, POLK COUNTY, IOWA, AND CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 0.15 ACRES (6,550 SQUARE FEET).

3. The Mayor is authorized and directed to sign the Offer to Purchase and Quit Claim Deeds for the conveyance as identified above, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed to attest to the Mayor's signature.
4. The City Manager is authorized to sign any minor and non-substantial amendments to the purchase agreement and is further authorized to grant any temporary rights of entry for construction-related activities prior to closing.
5. Upon proof of payment of the consideration plus \$113.00 for publication and recording costs, the City Clerk is authorized and directed to forward the original of the Quit Claim Deeds, together with a certified copy of this resolution and of the affidavit of publication of the notice of this hearing, to the Real Estate Division of the Engineering Department for the purpose of causing said documents to be recorded.

The Real Estate Division Manager is authorized and directed to forward the original of the Quit Claim Deeds, together with a certified copy of this resolution and of the affidavit of publication of the notice of this hearing, to the Polk County Recorder's Office for the purpose of causing these documents to be recorded.

7. Upon receipt of the recorded documents back from the Polk County Recorder, the Real Estate Division Manager shall mail the original of the Quit Claim Deeds and copies of the other documents to the grantee.

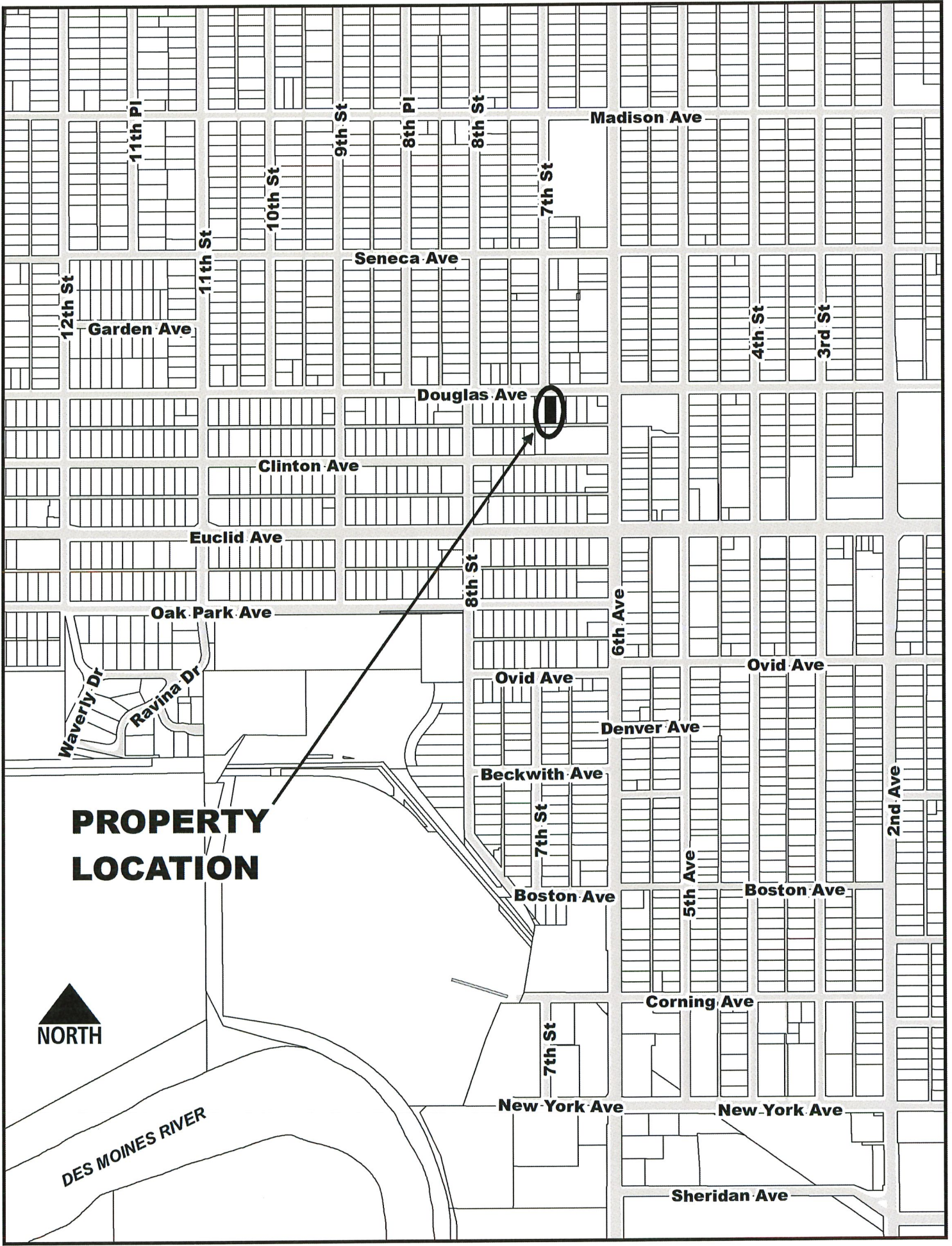
